“I know. I’ll buy some after taking a shower,” says Mom.

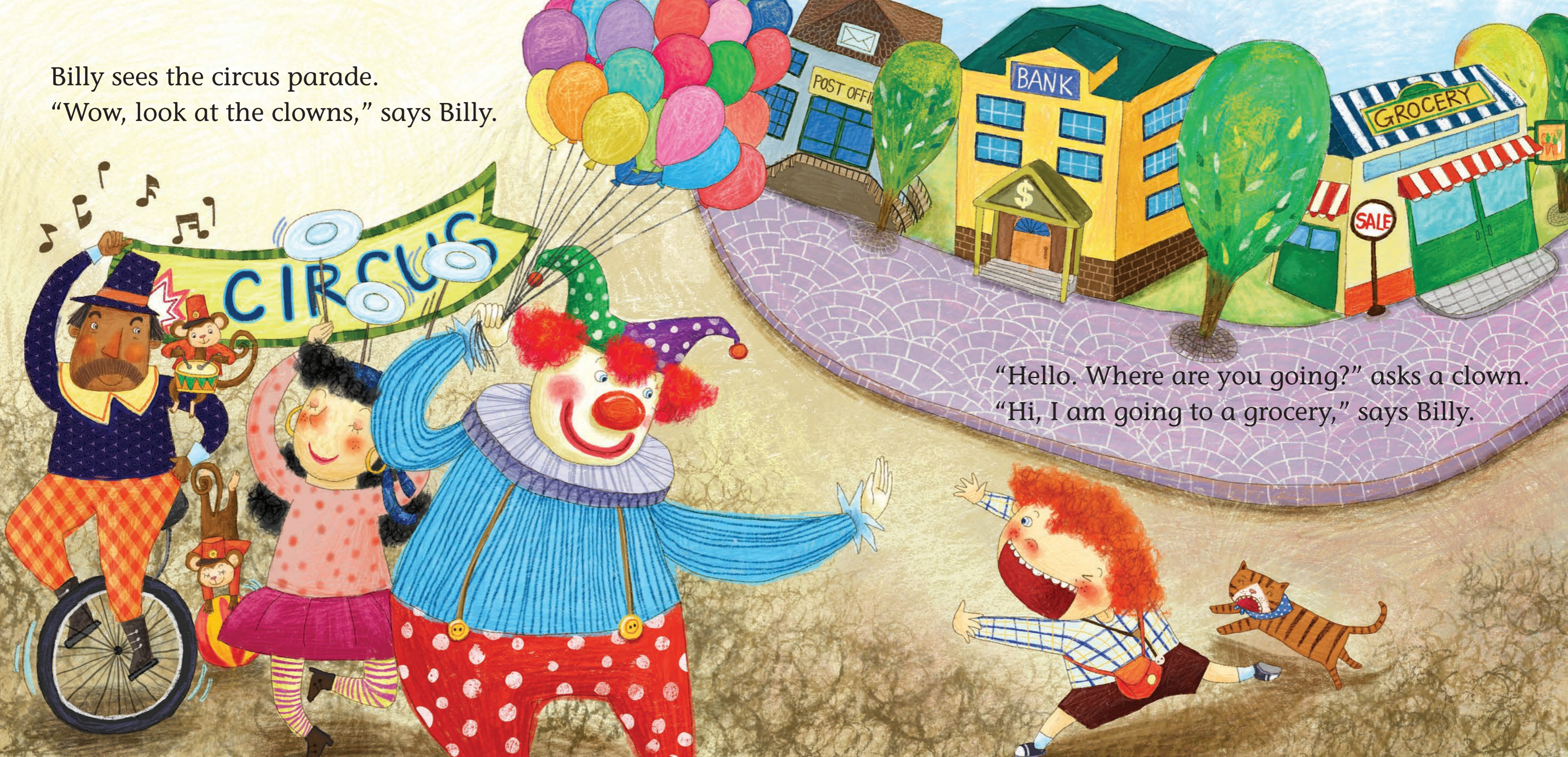
“I can buy it,” says Billy.

“Can you? Okay,” says Mom.

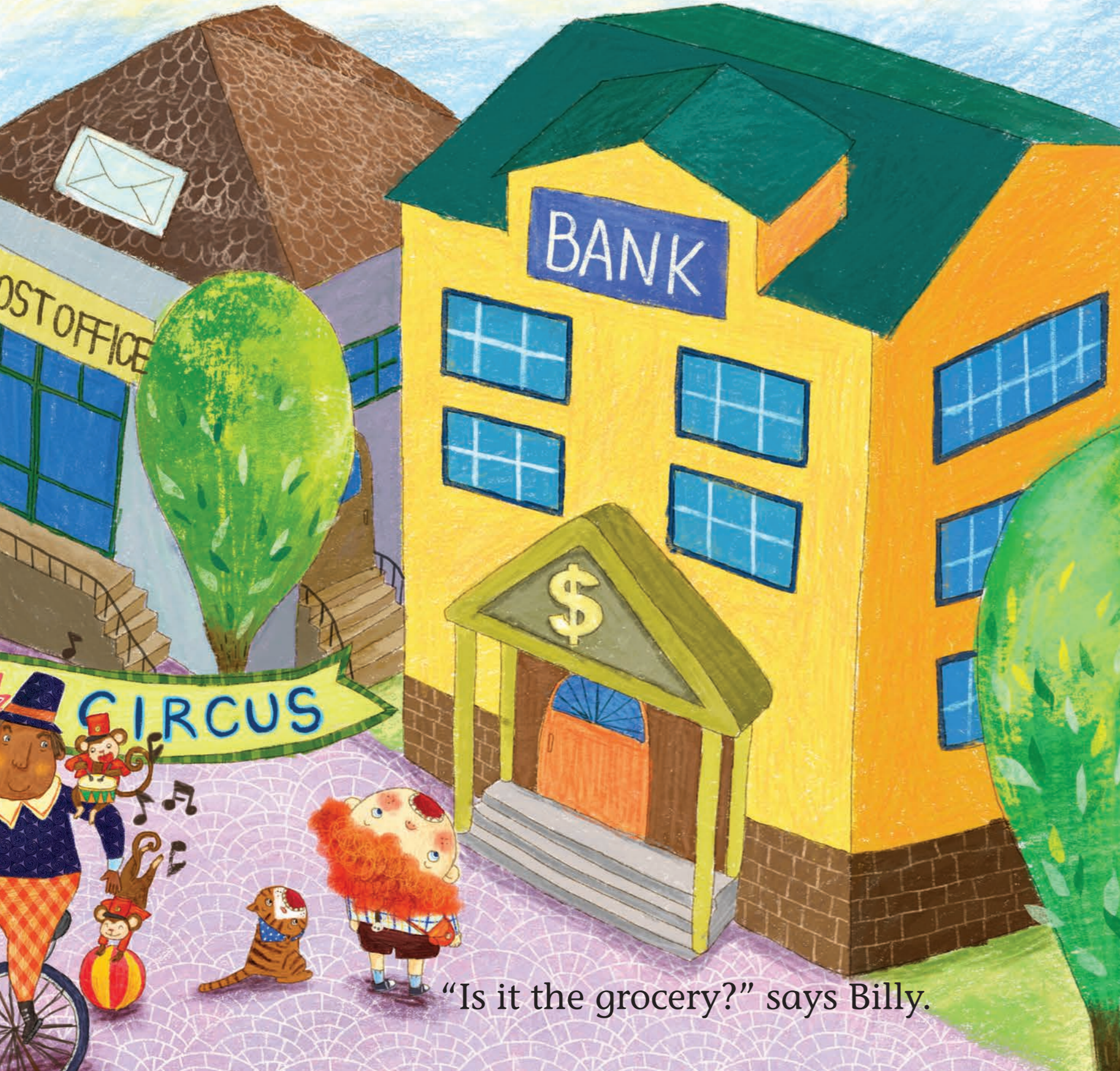
“Go to the grocery across the street.”
